A TYPICAL 'GJF' MEETING

A suggested outline for a GJF evening. It is the responsibility of the leader, with the group, to decide on a format. There is much freedom to develop the GJF format.

- Opening: A few songs to welcome the presence of the Holy Spirit. The leader prays an opening prayer to invite the Holy Spirit, His anointing, and His protection. The prayer used by the Mississauga group will be made available on the website.
- Silence and intercession: After a period of quiet to acknowledge the presence of God, members will individually have an opportunity to voice particular intentions.
- Announcements: The leader announces different events, conferences, retreats, etc coming up in the local area that would promote spiritual growth for the group members or their family and friends.
- Content: The group then moves into the three-week cycle: sharing on life, evangelization, or an open sharing or teaching.
- Conclusion: The meeting ends at the agreed upon time with a closing prayer. Simple snacks and hospitality to follow.

Please note that a GJF meeting would also be a wonderful addition to a Charismatic type prayer meeting. After a time for praise and worship and prophetic words, etc, the members would then break into small groups for a deep sharing. In that context, it may be only half an hour or an hour of a GJF format. GJF can be adapted into many various situations.
